



President Faure Gnassingbé inaugurates 50 MWp Solar Power Plant commissioned by Jakson in Togo



President Faure Essozimna Gnassingbé inaugurated a 50MWp Solar Power Plant today at Blitta Village in Togo. The Sheikh Mohamed Bin Zayed Solar Power Plant Project is being developed by AMEA Power, Dubai and designed, installed, commissioned, and executed by Jakson Group. The plant would supply power to nearly 600,000 households as well as 700 small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in the region. The plant is expected to supply 90,255 GWh of electricity to the grid annually. The Foundation Stone for the solar plant was laid by President Gnassingbé in February 2020.
