





Jakson Group has announced the establishment of its new division Jakson Green. This new segment has been developed to focus on new and emerging areas in the renewable energy sector like green hydrogen, ammonia, waste to energy, electrolysers, fuel cells, utility-scale battery

energy storage systems, solar, and related operations and maintenance services.
