Jakson to develop ammonia plant at Deendayal Port

MoU signed to develop green ammonia facility at Rs 2,400 crore

#NEW DELHI

Jakson Green on Thursday said it has inked an initial pact with Deendayal Port Authority to develop Rs 2,400 crore green ammonia plant at Kandla Port in Gujarat.

This landmark project marks a significant milestone in India's sustainable energy transition, a company statement said.

Jakson Green Private Ltd has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Deendayal Port Authority to set up a green ammonia facility, valued at approximately Rs 2,400 crore, it said.



According to the statement, the green ammonia facility, situated at Kandla Port, Gujarat, will be developed in a phased approach, with a projected annual production capacity of 1,33,000 tonnes of green ammonia.

Additionally, this endeavour is

poised to create more than 5,000 jobs, including O&M, thereby fostering substantial economic growth in the region, it added.
