The first half of the year has been encouraging and reflects the passion, commitment, and perseverance of every Jaksonite. However, as we review our progress against the Annual Operating Plan (AOP), we recognize the need to push harder, aim higher, and deliver stronger outcomes.

As we navigate the second half of the year, our focus must sharpen on **execution, excellence, strategic collaboration and operational discipline.** By strengthening our accountability and being mindful of the resources, I am confident we can achieve the goals we have set for ourselves.

In line with our vision for a better tomorrow, we are focused on investing in sustainable assets. With our largest-ever capex of over ₹8,000 crore, we are establishing a greenfield 6 GW integrated solar manufacturing facility in Madhya Pradesh, the largest in the state. In Phase I, we will commission 4 GW of solar module capacity and 3 GW of solar cell manufacturing capacity, further strengthening our integrated solar value chain and contributing to the 'Make in India' and Aatmanirbhar Bharat vision.

Adding to this momentum, we recently signed our first Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) for a utility-scale wind project, marking Jakson's entry into the wind energy sector. This development expands our renewable energy portfolio and positions us to play a pivotal role in India's clean energy transition, building on our strengths in solar and hybrid energy solutions.

As a leading renewable energy player, we were pleased to host Sri Lanka's Hon'ble Energy Minister, Eng. Kumara Jayakody, and Maldives' State Minister for Environment & Tourism, Mr. Muaviyath Mohamed, at our Solar Module Manufacturing Facility in Greater Noida, a visit that reflects the trust global leaders place in our capabilities and shared commitment to advancing clean energy.

Beyond these milestones, we continue to advance our sustainability agenda by embedding environmental, social, and governance (ESG) principles across all our operations. The ideas and energy of our new joiners and interns are fuelling innovation and adding fresh momentum to this journey. As we move into Q3, our priorities remain clear, delivering operational excellence, maintaining quality in execution, and upholding the financial discipline that has defined Jakson for nearly eight decades.

Together, we are shaping a future powered by purpose and progress, one that strengthens Jakson's legacy of leadership while creating lasting value for our people, partners, and planet.






