





QUALITY EDUCATION



At Jakson, we believe that the foundation of a better tomorrow lies in quality education today. Our Early Learning Centres (ELCs), operated in partnership with the Niveda Foundation under the Jakson Welfare Trust, continue to transform the lives of underprivileged children across Kasna (Uttar Pradesh), Kalsar (Gujarat), and Phaltan (Maharashtra). These centers provide non-formal education to girls aged 2–6 years, many of whom come from migrant and economically challenged families with limited access to basic educational facilities.

A. The Jakson Early Learning Center's – Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat & Maharashtra

Early Learning Impact: 2024–25:

With the support of Jakson Limited, the Niveda Foundation identified and mobilized 94 underprivileged girls across the three ELCs, focusing on holistic development and readiness for formal schooling. These centers operate from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM, providing structured education, nutrition, hygiene, and emotional care through trained teachers.

Project Locations:

Kasna, Uttar Pradesh

Located in Greater Noida, Kasna is home to over 50,000 people, including around 5,000 children. The area lacks access to quality education, with only a handful of informal learning centres. Most families are migrants from states like West Bengal, Bihar, Uttarakhand, and Odisha, earning daily wages through occupations such as rickshaw pulling, vegetable vending, and labor work. With the support of Jakson Limited, the Niveda Foundation established the Early Learning



Centre at H-132 on 15th April 2018, enrolling 35 non-school-going girls.

Kalsar, Gujarat- Situated in Pardi Taluka of Valsad district, Kalsar has a population of 9,000 and a female literacy rate of just 19.8%. The village comprises primarily agrarian families, some of whom have migrated from other states. Socio-economic challenges and poor educational infrastructure hinder learning outcomes. Supported by the Jakson Welfare Trust, the Niveda Foundation launched the Early Learning Centre on 4th September 2018 to bridge this gap.

Phaltan, Maharashtra- Phaltan, a taluka in Satara district, is a semi-urban region with a literacy rate of 75%. While many residents are local, migrant families from other states also form part of the community. Income sources include farming, domestic work, and daily wage labour. To support the early education needs of underprivileged children, the Niveda Foundation established the Phaltan Early Learning Centre on 1st April 2019 with assistance from Jakson Limited.

Project Objectives -

To provide one year of quality non-formal education to underprivileged girls, preparing them for formal schooling. The initiative aims to build confidence, strengthen foundational skills, and empower them to become responsible and informed citizens.

a. Academic Progress & Mainstreaming

All 94 children underwent annual academic assessments, with 86% achieving Grade A across subjects like English, Hindi, Mathematics, and regional languages (Marathi/Gujarati). These results reflect significant improvements in early literacy and numeracy skills. These students are now equipped to transition confidently into formal schooling.


Annual & Half Yearly Examination



Impact Stories: Real Lives, Real Change

Gauri Kumari, Age 8 – Kasna ELC Gauri comes from a family of factory workers in Kasna, where limited income and long hours left her working parents struggling to support her education. A quiet and reserved child, Gauri had difficulty expressing herself and lacked confidence. Enrolling in the ELC marked turnina point—she а began activities, participating in group discovered a love for creative arts like drawing and dance, and gradually overcame her shyness. Today, Gauri is an enthusiastic learner who dreams of becoming a police officer. Her story exemplifies how structured learning can unlock potential and instill purpose.





Akshara Adsul, Age 5 - Phaltan ELC Akshara faced overwhelming challenges early in life. Her father, once a farmer, was left partially paralyzed, and her mother had to take up domestic work to sustain the family. Despite being enrolled in school, Akshara struggled academically due to lack of attention and a difficult home environment. After joining the Phaltan ELC, she received personalized support that helped her strengthen her basics in language and mathematics. Akshara not improved academically but also gained the confidence to speak at public events. Her transformation highlights the power of focused care and inclusive learning environments.



Hiya Patel, Age 4 - Kalsar ELC Hiya's family faced severe financial strain, especially after her mother's hospitalization. Initially, Hiya was stubborn and inattentive, often resisting instruction. However, teachers at the Kalsar ELC recognized her interest in English and channelled it to spark her academic engagement. Over time, she developed patience, discipline, and a keen interest in learning. With support from the centre-which also eased the family's financial burden through free education, meals, and resources—Hiya is promising student aspirations to become a doctor.



Through consistent support, structured learning, and community involvement, Jakson's Early Learning Centres continue to spark change at the grassroots level, helping every child we reach build the courage to dream—and the skills to achieve those dreams.

This initiative, in collaboration with Abhinandan Educational and Welfare Society, aims to provide a safe and nurturing environment for underprivileged and at-risk children.

Key Highlights of the AbhiKIDS CARE Centre Program:

- Safe Learning Spaces: Established in Greater Noida, the centre offers a secure and supportive environment for unattended children, ensuring protection from exploitation, abuse, and trafficking.
- Education & Skill Development: The program provides remedial education, foundational literacy, vocational training, and career counseling to help children reintegrate into formal education and become self-reliant.
- Healthcare & Nutrition: Regular medical check-ups, nutritional support, and hygiene workshops are conducted under the Baala Project in Noida to improve children's overall well-being.
- Women's Empowerment: The initiative provides employment opportunities for women as caregivers, enabling them to achieve financial independence and support their families.
- Employee Volunteering: Jakson employees actively participate through mentorship, awareness sessions, and skill-building workshops for children and caregivers.



Quality Education: Transforming Lives

Jakson Group is committed to ensuring access to quality education for underprivileged children. As part of this mission, we have:

- Adopted 18 government schools and established three early learning centers for girls across Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, and Gujarat, providing world-class preschool education.
- Encouraged school enrolment among young girls who previously lacked access to education.
- Introduced career guidance and vocational training programs for adolescent girls to promote financial independence and skill development.

This program focuses on two critical areas: Solar Rooftop PV Systems/Solar PV Installers (Suryamitra) and Green Hydrogen Plant Entrepreneurship.

Program Overview and Objectives

The "Green Energy Skills" Project officially began on October 3, 2024, with the Solar (Suryamitra) batch starting on October 7, 2024. The program is conducted entirely offline, combining classroom theory with practical sessions in a well-equipped laboratory.

Our key objectives for this initiative include:

Equipping participants with employable skills in solar PV installation, operation, and maintenance, as well as in the emerging Green Hydrogen sector.

Encouraging entrepreneurial ventures within the renewable energy field.

Contributing to India's sustainability goals and the transition to green energy.

Supporting government efforts in skill development for the clean energy sector and India's National Solar Mission.

Training Highlights and Outcomes

This year, we successfully trained 60 participants across two batches:





- Solar Rooftop PV Systems/Solar PV Installers (Suryamitra) Batch:
 - Training Duration: 480 hours, from October 7, 2024, to December 24, 2024.
 - Participants: 30 trainees (2 females, 28 males).
 - Assessment: Held on January 10, 2025, achieving a 100% success rate for all 30 students.
 - Certification: All qualified participants will receive a certification from SCGJ, enhancing their job prospects in the solar energy industry.
- Green Hydrogen Plant Entrepreneur Batch:
 - Training Duration: 420 hours, from December 5, 2024, to March 18, 2025.
 - Participants: 30 trainees (7 females, 23 males).
 - Assessment: Scheduled for March 18, 2025.

Both training programs were conducted at the Image Engineering and Technical Institute in Kheda, Gujarat, offering both classroom conceptual learning and practical, hands-on experience with the latest equipment.

Real-World Exposure and Mentorship

To bridge the gap between academic knowledge and industry demands, we integrated comprehensive practical components:

- On-Job Training (OJT) for Suryamitra Batch: Participants of the Solar (Suryamitra) batch received seven days of OJT at Heemsol Energy System Pvt Ltd in Ahmedabad. Under expert guidance, they gained practical experience by installing real rooftop solar PV systems, learning client relations, site administration, and practical troubleshooting and maintenance. This experience significantly improved their employability skills and practical understanding.
- Site Visit for Green Hydrogen Batch: Participants in the Green Hydrogen Entrepreneurship program visited the Green Hydrogen Production Plant, a demonstration unit at the Gujarat Energy Research and Management Institute





- (GERMI) in Gandhinagar. This visit provided practical insights into real-world applications, enhancing their understanding of key concepts.
- Online Interactive Meet with Green Hydrogen Experts: The Jakson Group, SCGJ, and GORenewable Technology organized a special online session for Green Hydrogen participants. The session aimed to motivate participants, raise awareness about emerging opportunities, and provide industry insights from leading experts, including Mr. Sanjeev Kaul, Mr. E.K.S. Sreekumar, and Mr. Bhaskar Bose from Jakson Green Pvt. Ltd. Experts discussed the evolving landscape, growth opportunities, technological advancements, and the role of entrepreneurship in sustainable energy solutions, emphasizing skill development and innovation. Participants engaged in meaningful discussions, gaining practical understanding of industry expectations and career prospects.

Program Impact and Future Directions

This training program has successfully equipped 60 individuals with employable skills, empowering them to pursue careers in solar PV installation and Green Hydrogen, or even explore business ventures in renewable energy. - 1. Increase awareness about menstrual hygiene and encourage the adoption of reusable and eco-friendly menstrual products.
- 2. Educate women about the importance of addressing health concerns related to iron deficiency, anemia, and osteoporosis.
- 3. Build the capacity of women champions to advocate for menstrual health, hygiene, and nutrition within their communities.

Foster sustainable practices and create a supportive environment for women's health and empowerment.





Key Activities

- Awareness Workshops: Conducted interactive sessions on menstrual health, hygiene, and reproductive well-being.
- Distribution of Sustainable Products: Reusable menstrual kits were provided to all beneficiaries, promoting eco-friendly hygiene management.

With a dedicated medical team comprising 9 doctors and 57 paramedical staff, the hospital provides essential healthcare services such as:

- · Emergency and trauma care
- ENT and cataract surgeries
- Maternity and gynecology services
- Operation theatre procedures

For thousands of underserved families, this hospital is a critical healthcare lifeline.

Medical Equipment Provided

To enhance the hospital's capabilities and service delivery, the following life-saving medical equipment was provided:





- Birthing Bed (CE Marked): Ensures safe, hygienic, and supportive conditions for maternal deliveries. Strengthens maternal and child healthcare and aids in reducing maternal and infant mortality rates.
- Cardiac Monitor: Installed in the ICCU, this device allows continuous monitoring of vital signs, enabling timely intervention in cardiac and life-threatening emergencies.
- Operation Theatre Table (CE Marked): Enhances surgical efficiency and safety by supporting precision in a variety of complex medical procedures.

Impact Created

The upgraded medical equipment has resulted in:

 Improved Emergency Response: Doctors and staff can now deliver faster and more accurate care during critical medical situations.

- Enhanced Maternal Health Services: The birthing bed provides a safer environment for mothers and newborns, contributing to healthier delivery outcomes.
- Expanded Surgical Capacity: The OT table allows more complex procedures to be conducted locally, reducing referrals and patient travel burdens.

- PMT Set (Fine): Supports surgeons during delicate interventions, enhancing procedural accuracy.
- Dental Surgical Tools:
 - Extraction Forceps Kit, Periosteal Elevator, Bone Rongeur Cutter: Essential for oral and maxillofacial surgeries, reducing trauma and improving recovery time.



 Plastic Filling Instruments, Periodontal Curettes, K-File, Niti File, Spreader, GP Cone, Composite Instrument & Polishing Kit: A complete dental care toolkit supporting both preventive and restorative treatments.

Impact on Healthcare Delivery

The upgraded equipment has significantly improved the CHC's capacity to deliver safe and efficient healthcare services:

- Enhanced Surgical Outcomes: Shadowless lighting and advanced OT tools ensure higher surgical precision and patient safety.
- Expanded Dental Services: Equipped with modern instruments, the center now addresses a broader range of oral health issues—from extractions to fillings and periodontal care—previously out of reach for many low-income families.
- Improved Emergency Response: The electrosurgical unit supports minimally invasive surgeries, reducing risk and recovery time.





Reaching the Underserved

CHC Bhangel acts as the first point of healthcare contact for thousands of low-income households, including daily wage earners and migrant laborers who cannot afford private medical services. Strengthening its OT and dental units ensures:

- Access to affordable and quality care close to home
- Reduced patient load on tertiary hospitals
- Timely intervention for emergency and dental cases

Building Sustainable Health Systems

This intervention not only strengthens infrastructure but also supports the long-term sustainability of the public health system by:

Empowering local doctors and paramedics with appropriate tools

- Reducing referral rates to overburdened city hospitals
- Enhancing community trust in government health services

N4). Life-Saving Equipment for TB Eradication – Nandurbar, Maharashtra

As part of Jakson Group's commitment to supporting public health systems in underserved regions, a portable high-frequency X-Ray unit (XSNAP XB30 Plus) was provided to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Maharashtra, specifically for deployment in Nandurbar district. This contribution directly supports the Pradhan Mantri TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan, aligned with India's goal of eliminating tuberculosis (TB) by 2025.





Addressing a Critical Healthcare Gap

Nandurbar, a tribal and socio-economically disadvantaged district, has long struggled with inadequate healthcare access and limited diagnostic capabilities. The absence of timely screening often leads to delayed treatment and increased risk of TB transmission within the community. Recognizing these challenges, Jakson's intervention bridges a critical gap by enabling on-the-spot diagnosis through mobile medical infrastructure, allowing frontline health workers to reach remote, hard-to-access areas.

Equipment Support and Benefits

- XSNAP XB30 Plus Portable High-Frequency X-Ray Machine
 - Enables quick, accurate, and reliable TB diagnosis in field settings
 - Enhances early detection, which is crucial to controlling the spread of TB



- Reduces dependence on distant diagnostic centers, improving treatment compliance

This effort exemplifies Jakson's belief that access to diagnostic and life-saving tools is a right, not a privilege, and reflects the company's long-standing commitment to building a healthier, more resilient India.

Environment Sustainability

A) Project Prakriti: Cultivating a Greener Future in Greater Noida

 Project Prakriti, supported by the Jakson Group in partnership with Vyaktitva Foundation, is a dedicated afforestation initiative located in Momnathal Village, Sector 150, Greater Noida. This project aims to significantly contribute to environmental well-being through strategic tree plantation and long-term maintenance.

Project Overview and Environmental Impact

 The primary objective of Project Prakriti was to plant a total of 1,000 trees of various native species on land provided by the NOIDA Authority. These efforts directly contribute to mitigating climate change by absorbing carbon dioxide and restoring land fertility.

A key highlight of the project's impact:

- Carbon Sequestration: The 1,000 trees planted can potentially sequester approximately 1,110 kgs of carbon dioxide in their initial years.
- Oxygen Production: These trees are also estimated to produce 10,000 kgs of oxygen during their initial growth phase.
- Survival Rate: Following the initial plantation in Year 1, Year 2 focused intensely on regular maintenance, including manuring, mulching, and watering. This dedicated effort has ensured a 100% survival rate, with all 1,000 saplings/trees standing tall and healthy as of the current date.

Site Visits and Capacity Building







- Regular oversight and continuous improvement are integral to Project Prakriti's success:
- Jakson Team Visit: On July 10, 2024, the Jakson team, including CSR Head Ms.
 Anita Malik, visited the site to assess and commend the maintenance work.
 Valuable suggestions for site improvement were keenly noted and implemented.
- Natural Farming Training: Experts conducted a specialized training session with practical demonstrations on natural farming for the ground staff. This initiative aimed to empower the team with knowledge on preparing easy, on-site formulations for natural fertilizers and pest repellents, further enhancing sustainable practices.

Dedicated Plant Maintenance

- The sustained health and growth of the trees are a direct result of meticulous maintenance work, which includes:
- · Watering & Manuring: Ensuring adequate hydration and nutrient supply.
- Mulching & Grass Cutting: Protecting the soil and managing surrounding vegetation.
- De-Weeding: Removing competitive plants to allow the trees to thrive.
- Through Project Prakriti, Jakson Group, in collaboration with Vyaktitva Foundation, is not only planting trees but also cultivating a healthier environment and demonstrating a strong commitment to ecological restoration and climate action in the Greater Noida region.

B) Project Vasundhara: Enhancing Green Cover in Wathar Nimbalkar Village

 In August 2024, the Jakson Welfare Trust, in collaboration with Needsync Foundation, launched Project Vasundhara, a tree plantation drive aimed at increasing green cover and promoting environmental sustainability in Wathar Nimbalkar Village, Phaltan District, Satara. This initiative is designed to contributeto ecological balance, enhance biodiversity, and improve soil conservation in the region.

Project Achievements and Sustained Growth

- Over the past year, the Needsync Foundation has diligently monitored and maintained the plantation site, ensuring the healthy growth and survival of the saplings.
- A key milestone of Project Vasundhara is the achievement of a 100% survival rate for all planted saplings. This remarkable success is a direct result of consistent care, structured monitoring, and timely interventions.

Our maintenance efforts included:

- Regular Site Visits: The Needsync Foundation team conducted regular site visits to assess the health of each tree, promptly addressing issues like wilting or pest infestation.
- Mulching: Mulch was applied around the base of the saplings to retain moisture, regulate soil temperature, and prevent weed growth, significantly improving their survival prospects.
- Weed and Grass Clearance: Wild grass and invasive weeds were systematically removed from the plantation area throughout the year, ensuring saplings received essential nutrients and water, while also minimizing pest risks and improving the site's visual appeal.
- Soil Enrichment and Pest Control: Organic manure and natural fertilizers were applied to enhance soil fertility, and eco-friendly pest management techniques were used to protect the saplings.
- Structural Support: Some saplings received additional support from wooden stakes to ensure upright growth and resilience against environmental stresses.

Innovative Drip Irrigation System

• To ensure efficient and consistent watering, a drip irrigation system was installed across the entire plantation area. This sustainable and water-efficient solution was critical given the region's climatic conditions and water availability.

The system's key components include:

- A 2000-litre water tank for storage and supply regulation.
- A network of pipelines strategically laid to distribute water throughout the area.
- Drip emitters positioned at the base of each sapling, delivering water directly to the root zone to minimize wastage and promote deep root growth.

This system has significantly reduced water wastage and manual watering efforts, contributing to the healthy establishment of the saplings by maintaining consistent soil moisture levels.

Conclusion and Future Outlook

The tree plantation initiative at Wathar Nimbalkar Village under Project Vasundhara has achieved remarkable success, with all trees thriving due to structured care and well-planned interventions. The 100% survival rate, successful implementation of drip irrigation, and diligent maintenance efforts underscore Needsync Foundation's commitment to environmental sustainability.

The Jakson Welfare Trust extends its sincere gratitude to Needsync Foundation for their dedication and partnership in this initiative. This collaboration has established a strong foundation for a greener future, and we are eager to continue scaling similar



projects in the coming years. Together, we are taking significant steps towards ecological conservation and sustainability, committed to nurturing and expanding these vital efforts.
